

Roman Motulskii outlined the structure of professional education in Belarus. There are 2 secondary colleges, higher education in the University of Culture, and doctoral studies at the same University.

The Faculty of Librarianship consists of three departments: Library Science; Bibliography and Documentation; and Informatics. They have computer equipment of Belorussian production that is sufficient for teaching. The staff consists of 45 persons, among them 30 with doctoral degrees. They have to teach for 800 hours

per year. 33% of students are paying for tuition. The level of professional knowledge and skills satisfies the employers. However, graduates do not go for jobs to the libraries, looking for better salaries in other sectors.
